A. Blood Donation Camp:

We organized a total of **8 Blood Donation camps** from January 2024 to March 2024.

More than **320 units** of blood were collected from these camps.

B. Free Health Check-up Camp:

We organized a total of **12 Free Health Check-up camps** from January 2024 to March 2024 in villages and urban slums of Dehradun. **About 1600 patients** most of them belonging to **the marginalised population** were examined and were given free medications. C. Corporate Health Check-up Camps:
